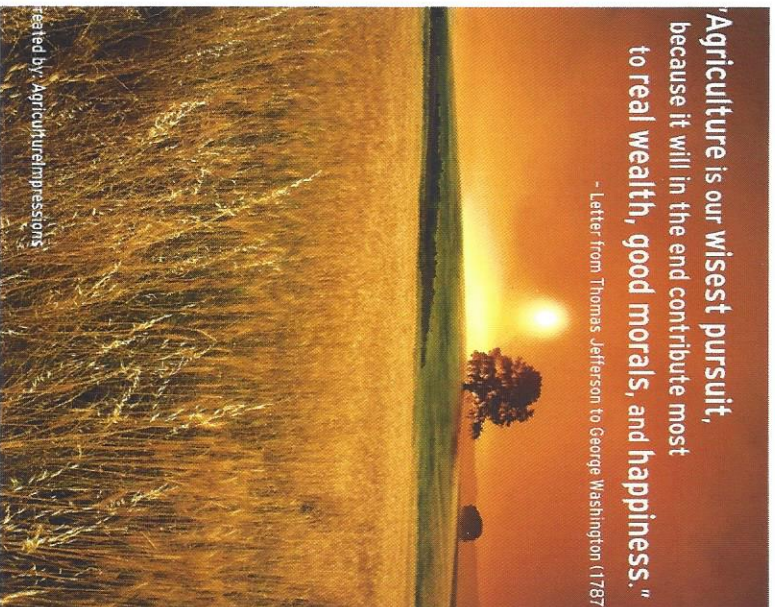

## DONATING GRAIN

It is easy to donate your grain to benefit a scholarship for a Schuyler county student.

All you have to do is let Western Grain Marketing know how many bushels you would like to donate and they will deposit the check from that grain into the Scholarship Foundation's account.

The Foundation is a 501(c) (3) organization, which makes your donation tax exempt. Western Grain Marketing can give you a receipt to use for tax purposes.



## WHO BENEFITS FROM YOUR DONATION

Students who reside or their parent(s) reside in Schuyler county can apply for a Scholarship. Students do not have to be members of Farm Bureau to receive a scholarship but they must be enrolled in a federally approved post-high school educational institution by the fall of same year applying. Monetary donations are also accepted by mailing a check to the Schuyler County Farm Bureau; PO Box 20; Rushville, IL 62681 with the attention to the Foundation. Please be advised you may want to contact your tax accountant to determine tax implications prior to donating your grain.
